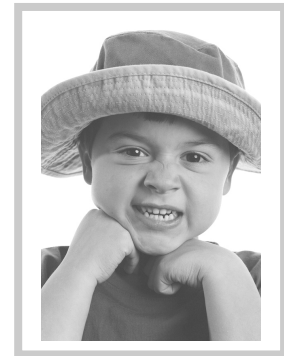


# Is Your Child Making the Transition from Birth to Three to Preschool?

**Directions to the Early Care and Education Training Institute's Seminar Room at the Executive Office Towers, Suite B2, 30 Main Street, Danbury**

From Route 84 take Exit 5 Eastbound, at the end of the ramp go straight down Down's St. At the intersection of Main St. turn right. Go about 1.5 miles through 7 lights. 30 Main Street is shortly after the Green ends (next to the Getty Station) and across the street from A&P Super Foodmart,

From Route 84 Westbound take Exit 5, turn right off the exit go through 8 lights. 30 Main Street is shortly after the Green ends (next to the Getty Station) and across the street from A&P Super Foodmart.

The meeting space is in the basement. Follow the signs, taking the elevator to the lower level.
